ATTENDEE RULES & CONDITIONS

Entry to this private event constitutes full acceptance of the following conditions. These rules are enforced to maintain security, privacy, and an optimal experience for all participants.

1. ACCESS & ADMISSION

This is a private event with limited capacity. Admission is controlled at all times. The organizers reserve the right to deny, revoke, or temporarily restrict entry as needed to maintain security, attendee flow, and overall event operations. Valid government-issued identification is mandatory. No ID, no entry. Public access begins at 10:00 AM on May 6. Entry may be limited or paused at any time based on capacity.

2. IDENTIFICATION

Name badges must be worn visibly at all times within the event space. Attendees without visible credentials may be denied access or removed.

3. SECURITY & LIABILITY

Active security personnel will be present at all times. Security cameras will be in operation throughout the event for safety and monitoring purposes. Keep all valuables secured at all times.

4. RECORDING POLICY

Recording or filming outside the firm during the auction or show is strictly prohibited due to insurance requirements and bidder privacy. The auction will be professionally broadcast online for registered bidders. Auction participation requires separate registration and is not included with show admission.

5. FOOD & BEVERAGE
